Below is an outline of the classroom discipline plan.

Class Rules:

- 1. Follow directions including all school rules.
- 2. Come prepared for class (pen, paper, notebook/flash drive, and work).
- 3. Keep hands and feet to yourself.
- 4. Use kind words.

Supportive Feedback (some examples):

- 1. verbal recognition
- 2. positive notes and phone calls home
- 3. special privileges: first out of class, run teacher errand
- 4. class wide rewards: lesson plan preference vote, class music (approved music only), snack permission

Corrective Actions:

First time a student breaks a rule: warning Second time: last to leave class and/or detention Third time: call parents and conference Fourth time: principal referral Severe Clause: call parents and principal referral-may be implemented as needed at any time

At any time that the student may be frustrated by a rule and/or does not follow classroom expectations of behavior, the student may write a note to the teacher explaining his/her frustration. A student choosing to write a note to the teacher must complete any missing class work from that day as homework that evening.
